Kentler International Drawing Space, founded by two artists in 1990, is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that brings important and timely exhibitions of contemporary drawings and works on paper to the public by local, national and international artists. The gallery encourages artists to experiment, explore, and expand the definitions of art in society, creating the opportunity for dialogue and interaction.

The Kentler Flatfiles were started as part of the gallery's inception in 1990. The Flatfiles, a compendium of artworks by over 160 artists archived in flat files, have become an important resource for artists, collectors, curators and the general public by stressing the importance of drawing and work on paper in contemporary art today. The Flatfiles are located behind the gallery and are available for viewing by appointment. The Kentler also has a Satellite Flatfile at *Proteus Gowanus**, which focuses on Artists' prints. Curators are invited to make selections from the Kentler Flatfiles for exhibitions at the gallery on a rotating basis.
