Kentler International Drawing Space is pleased to present *Water Prayers*, an exhibition of drawings by Nancy Manter. Her work will be on view in the front gallery space from February 15th – March 31st. A brochure with an essay by Stephen Maine accompanies the exhibition.

Nancy Manter responds to current global weather patterns and the volatility of our natural environment with her large-scale works on roofing paper. Using graphite, conte crayon and acrylic gesso, she interprets the formal properties of water, snow and ice onto a surface associated with shelter and protection.

In its exploration of order, chaos, and the psychological implications of life on a changing planet, *Water Prayers* is both timely and site-specific. As Red Hook struggles in the aftermath of Hurricane Sandy, Manter's atmospheric exhibition invites needed contemplation and refuge.
